My Story

This is the story of my life up until now.

It could be called a testimony, but I'm just calling my story because it has taken nearly a lifetime to play out.

Stage 1: birth to age 20

my worldview development

I was born in 1948 approximately 2 months premature, weighing only 3 lbs at the Duke Hospital.

Very shortly thereafter, I developed pneumonia.

Back in those days, very few infants survived pneumonia, let alone premature ones.

My Grandfather Whitehead told my Dad that I would never make it.

My Grandfather had no idea what the future held for his grandson.

God knew my whole life before it ever started.

He knows everyone's life, for He is the Author of life.

He knew that stage 5 was on the horizon.

As I grew up, I developed a worldview that represented the values of the home in which I grew up in.

Everybody has a worldview, even if they are not aware of it.

A worldview is how we look at and interpret any situation in life – it is the filter through which we process information in order to come to a decision or an opinion.

Everyone's worldview is different.

Whose worldview is correct?

We can argue that our entire life and never settle on the same answer.

Actually, a Biblical worldview is the correct one.

God made the world, God made humans, God made the rules of the universe and whether or not you agree, He is correct.

As I grew up in a very materialistic, social-oriented world, my views and opinions were being determined by my environment.

I went to Sunday school, church, and was taught right from wrong.

I never thought about the word "Christian", I just assumed I was one.

My assumption was not based on any Biblical knowledge.

It was just an opinion that was not thought about much.

During my high school years, I developed a strong work ethic around a goal that I established early on – I wanted to earn a basketball scholarship to a school in the ACC.

For four long years I worked at that goal 7 days a week, 52 weeks a year.

When my friends were doing other activities, I was in the gym practicing for my goal.

There is a price everyone must pay for **anything** in life that they want.

One must determine what that price is – how much of their life they are willing to exchange for it.

I achieved my goal during my senior year in high school by signing a fouryear scholarship to UNC.

I can remember very plainly a few days after signing, I was again in the gym practicing basketball.

Although, this time something was different.

I didn't have a goal to chase.

I felt empty.

My motivation was not the same.

I never thought about the actual playing of basketball in college – my whole focus in life was **earning** that scholarship.

My college basketball career was limited to 2 years.

I completely lost interest in basketball as other worlds opened up to me.

Satan was slowly establishing a base from which to operate in my soul.

After college, I went to work for BB&T in Wilson.

While at work one day, I was informed that my Dad had died; he was 49.

I was 22, young and dumb.

My life forever changed.

Stage 2: 22 – 23 years of age

my dad's death

My Dad was a great dad.

He and I were entirely different.

Farming was his life – he was devoted to being the very best farmer in the area.

Even his hobby was farming.

That's where we were different.

I did not grow up doing manual labor on the farm due to my dad's sharecropping method of farming.

I worked during the summers on the farm, but not doing the unpleasant labors involved in agriculture of the time.

I developed different hobbies and interests.

My dad and I were never close – we had different interests.

He died suddenly of suicide.

He was mentally depressed – a condition that was not talked about back then.

He had no professional help, and depression won.

Some life-changing decisions had to be made in order to ensure that our family farming operation would continue.

Stage 3: 23 -34 years of age:

living for self, society, & worldly goals

At the age of 23 with no idea about how to farm, I was suddenly thrust into a position of responsibility – something that was not familiar to me.

I did have a business education from college, but that was of little help in the daily running of a farm back then, except for the business accounting.

With help from family friends, we hired a long-time family associate of my dad's to be our farm manager.

I resigned from the bank and Mr. Anderson started teaching me how to farm.

I loved it.

I became obsessed with it.

During the years of the 70s, agriculture can into its own – it was very prosperous as American farmers began to trade on a world market.

I was successful, as were so many of my farming buddies.

Making money was easy.

I thought that I was responsible for my success.

This was a product of a distorted worldview. (false knowledge)

I was totally looking at life through the wrong lens.

I developed very ambitious goals and was well on my way to achieving them when all of a sudden, clouds appeared on the horizon.

Stage 4: 35 – 49 years of age: hurricane season

During the good years, I expanded the farm, started an oil distributorship with a service station, and entered the hog business, along with a

hardware store and a farm supply company and a gourmet peanut business; all of which were earthly goals.

In the **Bible**, **Jesus** calmed the storm on the Sea of Galilee; but on Grasunan Farm, **He** created the perfect storms, one after another.

Totally unaware to me, this was the beginning of my **now** eternal destiny.

God places storms (circumstances, events) into a person's life to teach, to correct or to lead that person.

Individuals respond to these circumstances differently; some think that it is just life happening; others gradually realize that a **higher power** is controlling their life.

Various areas of my several businesses began to crumble.

The oil business was the first to indicate something was going wrong.

I started experiencing depression for the first time in my life.

Year after year the storms continue to increase.

I had no idea what was happening.

All that I knew was that I was losing money at a very dangerous rate.

As it was losing money year after year, it pulled resources from the farming operation.

I had to turn things around or disaster was looming.

During all of this, I developed glaucoma and lost sight in one eye.

I was told that I was too young to be experiencing glaucoma.

My mother died of cancer after a five, year battle.

My mind was slipping further into depression.

As the years continued, my marriage became another victim.

My wife and I separated and both decided the children would be better off for them to live with her.

That was a crushing blow for me.

I had decided early in my life that I would be close to my children regardless of the cost; and I was and still am.

After the children left, things continued to get worst.

I was selling off hundreds of acres of farmland in an attempt to save our family farm.

Finally, I decided to get out of farming.

I can look back on what happened in my life and see something that never crossed my mind during the time – **Someone** was arranging the events in my life.

Changes were occurring too perfectly timed.

A new job opportunity appeared at an agri-business facility which I owned.

I took the job which allowed me to have more flexible hours than in farming.

This meant that I could travel to participate as a coach for my children's athletic careers.

What a wonderful blessing.

I also began dating a girl that I had not seen in 20 years.

We married and she entered into a very hard situation – that of being a step-mom in a family where the dad was totally engulfed with depression.

The storms continued.

I still had no idea why.

People with a distorted worldview cannot see the bigger picture of life – that life is being determined by God.

All in all, I lost seven-figure money, farmland, a fuel business, an agribusiness, before I finally collapsed on my bed and crying out to **God** wanting to know what was going on.

What did **He** want?

There in my bedroom **He** spoke with **His** silent voice deep in my soul – <u>He</u> wanted me.

Why in the world would the **God of Creation** want the broken, worn-out remnants of a once-successful man – a sinner?

"For I know the plans I have for you," declares the Lord, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future.

Then you will call on Me and come and pray to Me, and I will listen to you.

When you seek Me with <u>ALL</u> your heart, I will be found by you," declared the Lord". Jeremiah 29:11-14

What a powerful **Bible** verse.

Stage 5: 50 – 63 years of age:

salvation & enrollment in God U.

This contains the most important time period of my life.

What I learned during this stage was <u>life changing</u>.

I learned the "complete" gospel of Jesus Christ.

I knew <u>about</u> Him for all of my life; but getting to <u>know</u> Him on a <u>personal</u> level is completely different from just going to church and "hearing" about <u>Him</u>.

This stage involved reading the **Bible**, studying the **Bible** and developing a passion to follow and obey **Jesus** – an attempt to make **Him** number one in my life.

Two of my friends – Jim Branch & Kenneth Sykes – were aware of what was happening to me.

They stepped into my life and led me to accepting **Jesus** as my **Savior** at the Billy Graham retreat – The Cove.

I was the only man out of 600 to go forward to accept Jesus.

No one can become a **Christian** whenever they choose.

A person must be called by the **Holy Spirit** in order for the mystery surrounding the workings of the **Holy Spirit** in one's soul to occur.

"The call to salvation is a call to be on a mission with God".

Whenever you feel "something" urging you to Jesus, seize the moment; do not let it pass – it may never happen again.

My life changed dramatically thereafter.

The number 1 fact that I would love for any nonborn again Christian to get out of this story is:

You need to educate yourself on what God has to say about life and death and the requirements for getting into heaven.

It is not automatic.

The default destination for everyone is hell – because everyone is born as a sinner.

If you do not consider yourself a sinner, then why are you going to die one day?

And unless you learn what to do about that condition, that's where you are headed.

The main 2 hindrances for people in deciding to become a **Christian** are:

- 1 first realizing that they are not a Christian
- 2 the unwillingness to change & educate themselves.

Pride is behind both of those hindrances.

The Bible, "My people perish for lack of knowledge." Hosea 4:6

These hindrances did not bother me at all.

The Bible states that **God** starts everyone into Christianity with baby steps.

A person's advancement is based 100% on that person's willingness to learn and just what degree of a Christian they wish to become.

I started slowly, but I set a goal to become the best Christian that I could possibly be – I wanted everything God had planned for me.

Slowly my worldview began to change – I started seeing the same world differently – through Jesus' eyes.

I could see that I had everything upside down.

I had myself, my plans, my future, my fun, my wants, my, my, etc at the top of my agenda.

A true **Christian** has **Jesus** at the top of their agenda; everything else is secondary.

I now wear a wrist bracelet that has "I am second" on it.

A Christian has:

- Admitted to **God** that they are a sinner
- Repented from their "old" life style of self & sin
- Placed Jesus as LORD & Savior of their life.

The first two conditions were not hard, but the third took some time.

Repentance is turning away from the lifestyle you once lived and turning to **Jesus** for guidance.

Many, many people desire to have Jesus as their Savior, but **ONLY A FEW** have **Him** as their **LORD**.

Having Jesus as your LORD means that you allow **Him** to be in complete control of everything: your decisions

your agenda

your checkbook

your attitude

your everything.

"I tell you the truth, unless you are born again, you cannot see the Kingdom of God." Jesus

Jesus is telling the secret for entering heaven.

Being born again detours **Christians** off of the broad road of destruction onto the narrow road of salvation.

For wide is the gate and broad is the road that leads to destruction, and <u>MANY</u> enter through it.

But small is the gate and narrow is the road that leads to life,



These verses are words of Jesus.

The narrow road is the road less travelled.

He is the One Who determines who gets into heaven and who does not.

And **He** said that **Only A Few** are going to make it.

If you were to fly to New York today on United and the CEO of United assured you that the plane was going to crash, would you still take the flight?

God is speaking to us from **His Word** – the **Bible**.

Heaven is there for whosoever; but sadly, **ONLY A FEW** have the **Biblical** knowledge to get there.

Instead of Heaven being a person's goal in life, going to Heaven is actually a by-product of living a Christian life dedicated to Jesus.

A person's direction, not their intention, determines their destination.

The Principle of the Path Andy Snley's

If anything is more important to you than **God**, you have a direction problem.

Until a person experiences **God**, **He** is not real; **He** is only an opinion or a fact that you have heard about.

Someone may tell you that their pit bull is as friendly as a lamb; but until you experience a relationship with that pit bull, what they tell you is only an opinion.

A person must experience God/Jesus to gain true knowledge of Them.

Jesus tells us: "I AM the Way, the Truth, & the Life; NO man comes to the Father but by Me".

If a person is not changed by the **Holy Spirit** into a "new person" (new thoughts, beliefs, priorities, etc.), they are not born again and cannot pass through the sin wall that separates all sinners from **God & heaven**.

"I stand at the door and knock. If you hear My voice and open the door,
I will come in" Jesus Revelation 3:20

This is **Jesus** asking you to open the door of your heart to allow **Him** to come in.

When a person is truly born again, the change in that person is obvious to everyone who knows them.

Once a person's "flesh" is out of the way with its self-centered demands and time-bound outlook, the **Holy Spirit** can begin **His** work.

It is **God's** plan for saving mankind from itself.

There are two ways of being fooled in life:

- 1- to believe what is not true
- 2- to refuse to believe what is true.

Most people do not believe the born-again requirement although they believe in **God/Jesus**.

Today, people do not want to change from what they have been taught growing up.

Pride keeps them from admitting they may be wrong.

Who else better than **Jesus** can a person learn the truth from?

He is God.

Jesus has ONLY two choices when someone dies:

1- He will say, "I never knew you".

2- Or, He will say, "Enter into the joy of the Lord."

You will NOT have a say in the matter --- destiny set for eternity.

Jesus has never been wrong and He will NEVER be wrong.

There is so much **education needed**.

The **Holy Spirit** went to work on me, changing everything about me from the inside out.

My way of thinking, the people I want to associate with, my values, my desires, everything – my entire worldview of life.

I had to get rid of my "unknown gods" – materialism, power, money, etc. and replace them with Jesus.


Getting rid of "unknown gods" does not mean giving everything away; it means putting your love for Jesus and what He wants of you, ahead of your prior agenda.

The first commandment states that **God** will have no other gods ahead of **Him**.

This one fact keeps many people from becoming true Christians.

It is estimated (by surveys) that 80% of church-goers will <u>not</u> go to heaven.

ONLY A FEW.



Why?

Because most people think that they are just fine and are headed there.

This is such a sad situation.

To live one's entire life under a false assumption, to discover one second after death that they had everything wrong, is so sad.

Stage 6: 56 years of age

Romans 8:28

"Every day we are in a spiritual battle between God's forces and Satan's forces in the invisible realm and also in our minds.

The invisible spiritual war between good and evil is the ultimate stealth war.

It pits the two most powerful forces in existence in a fight to the finish.

The prize?

Your soul goes to the victor.

Every decision you make every day moves you closer to capture.

Human beings will fight this spiritual battle to the end with some having full knowledge of the outcome, yet millions will join the losing side.

There is no dispute about the end result – God wins!

You have been given the freedom to choose your side:

- 1- God's victory-bound army
- 2- Satan's live-for-the-moment losers.

Your choice should be a no-brainer, yet Satan deceives hundreds of millions of people, convincing them to reject God's offer of love in favor of Satan's offer of pleasures in this world.

Most people do not understand the intensity of the devil's evil nature.

Satan hates your guts.

He will search out your weaknesses and exploit them.

Every choice matters.

Choices of:

- language used
- beliefs
- friends
- what you do
- how you live
- everything.

Americans are not as concerned about the outcome of this spiritual battle (b/c they can't see it), as they are about <u>physical</u> <u>comfort</u>, <u>personal image</u>, <u>personal agenda</u>, and <u>material gain</u>.

People are **TOO** busy living to even think about this unseen battle.

They are Biblically ignorant and are already captured by Satan w/o even knowing it."

Think Like Jesus George Barna

When a person makes a stand for **Jesus**, they can be certain Satan will hit them hard, trying to discredit them.

My attack caught me by surprise.

I had been taking antidepressants for about 15+ years when I passed out twice one morning and was rushed to the ER.

After a week of tests, it was determined that I had a lethal amount of antidepressants in by blood stream.

Since my regular family doctor had retired, I was not having my blood levels checked regularly.

Over the years the antidepressant built up to a lethal level.

Just to explain to you how **God** looks after **His** children, over the prior weekend I visited Billy Graham's Cove training center in Asheville.

I forgot to take my medications with me.

On Monday morning I took the meds and then passed out.

The doctors told me that if I had taken the meds over the weekend, I would have died Monday.

God gave me two days without meds to soften the punch on Monday.

I had to undergo antidepressant withdrawal which was followed by discovering my thyroid was under producing (causing extra depression) and it had to be put to sleep.

I was suffering in double depression.

A new doctor put me on a new antidepressant – Romoran – which has been taken off the market for causing so many suicides.

I was living in "hell on this earth" with my head about to burst with depression.

I could not take it.

I opted out w/o going to God for help.

ALWAYS GO TO GOD FOR HELP WHEN YOU ARE HURTING.

I felt like my head was being hit with a hammer.

I tried to take my life.

As I sat in my truck with two cans of methyl bromide taped to the end of my pistol, I was ready to go to heaven.

My feelings were that tomorrow was not going to be any better.

I was not sure of God's view of suicide, so just before I pulled the trigger, I asked God: "Do not leave me nor forsake me".

This is verse found several places in the **Bible**.

I pulled the trigger and the poison sprayed everywhere, even into my mouth.

This is an instant knock-out poison.

I knew right away that I was not going to die.

God had acted faster than a speeding bullet in doing what He does best.

He saved me from death.

How, I do not have a clue.

He rearranged the laws of nature to work for **His** glory.

And we know that God causes <u>EVERYTHING</u> to work together for the good of <u>THOSE</u> who love God and are <u>CALLED</u> according to <u>HIS PURPOSE</u> for them. Romans 8:28

What the devil had meant for evil, **God** over-ruled it to demonstrate **His** power and glory.

Gra experienced God that day.

"We come to know God as we experience Him."

God has plans for Gra.

Stage 7: 56 – 57

finding my purpose

After sending time in the hospital, I was taken to a Christian shrink who worked with me for months to get the correct antidepressant.

Meanwhile, he told me to read <u>The Purpose Driven Life</u> by Rick Warren, which I did.

The first sentence of the book is: "Life is not about you."

After finishing the book, I realized that **God** created each of us with certain gifts and talents for a specific purpose in life.

It is our responsibility to discover **His** purpose for our life.

I did some deep thinking concerning this matter and concluded what my present passions were.

I came up with 2 immediate, clear-cut passions and a made-up third.

The first passion was my desire to serve **God** through my love of dogs.

The second was my desire to witness to or inform my friends as to what I had learned during the past 10 years concerning the true gospel.

The third included using my business degree to teach Christian business values to teens.

Immediately I created Down East Animal Refuge (DEAR), a 501 c3 no-kill, non-profit dog shelter.

With about 5 or 6 volunteers we went to work saving dogs.

My second passion or purpose was much slower in developing.

I wanted my statement to my friends to be meaningful and believable.

I presented it to 34 friends four years later in the form of a 32 page letter.

Only one individual had any worthwhile discussion concerning what I tried to get across them.

This has been so disheartening.

All God is expecting from me is to plant the seed.

Stage 8: 62

the vision

One day I was driving home from Norfolk, Va. and stopped to buy a lottery ticket. (I know the Christian view of this)

As I was going down the road I asked **God** if **He** would bless the ticket by allowing DEAR to win so that we could build a small facility of some sort to better draw people to our efforts.

He immediately responded clearly to me.

He told me, "To take care of your business, first."

This was my first recognizable communication from God/HS.

I knew exactly what **He** was referring to.

During the years in the hurricane season with constant depression, I had failed to file (not just pay; but to even file) 5 years of income tax records for 4 companies I had at the time.

I wanted a blessing for my dog venture, so I went to work on the tax situation.

In September of 2010, I filed the final tax return.

Nineteen days later, on October 19, 2010, God kept me awake all night.

Out of all the nights in my life since **God** spoke to me about taking care of my business, now (after doing what **He** told me to do), **He** did this.

He began what has become a slow process of revealing **His** vision and purpose for my life.

"When God gets ready for you to take a new step or direction in His activity, it will be in sequence with what He has already been doing in your life".

This first night, God began by guiding me in drawing a future dog complex.

This first design included two 500-foot kennels with water surrounding them.

I saved that first drawing.

The next week, God kept me awake again all night revising the plans.

This time **He** instructed me to have 11 kennels, one for each disciple except Judas, a cross-shaped central pond, and a cross-shaped central building.

Once again a week later, **God** kept me awake for another all-nighter.

The finishing touches were drawn into **God's** vision for my dog shelter/ministry.

"God does not ask you to dream up something you can do for Him."

I knew I had some homework to do, so I started putting together construction costs and operating budgets for the vision.

"When the opportunity comes, it is too late to prepare."

"While you are waiting, investigate.

The investigation will accomplish One of three things:

- confirm the divine origin of your vision
- give further definition and focus to the vision
- tip you off that you were mistaken about the vision."

"When God reveals to you what He is doing, that is when you need to respond."

This homework kept me busy for the next two years.

In the fall of 2011 I was riding in my truck with nothing on my mind, when God/HS spoke to me for the second time; He said, "You forgot the irrigation system for the vision."

I was surprised at the comment, but **He** was correct.

But in 2012, God/HS spoke for the third time saying: "Your cement is figured incorrectly."

Boy, this really got my attention.

"Somewhere in the facts collected while investigating, there will be proof that the vision is indeed God-ordained."

The incorrect cement figures were the proof.

"God is far more interested in accomplishing His kingdom purposes than you are." Experiencing God Blackaby & King

After consulting with a friend, I learned that I had divided by the wrong number in converting square feet into cubic feet for the cement.

WOW!

God was into His vision's details. He knew my figures were incorrect.

That correction saved a tremendous amount of money.

In the months following, I tried to create a name for this vision-dog ministry, but could not come up with a name that ideally identified the project.

One day as I travelled to visit another dog facility, I rounded a curve and saw a huge wooden cross beside the road.

Instantly, the name hit me - Crossdogs!

That's exactly how **God** works when one is willing to listen to **His** "quiet" voice within.

Revelation come from **God** within you.

Information comes from outside sources.

Stage 9: 64

The Lord of my life

This stage is critical in becoming a person whom **God** can use for **His** purposes on earth.

Many a man becomes a Christian having Jesus as their Savior, but ONLY A FEW have Jesus as their Lord of their life.

Many good things have happened to me during this time.

Most of these years have been consumed with educating myself about **God** and **His** ways.

Meanwhile, I have also been faithfully operating a small dog rescue kennel without much public awareness.

Finally, one day I realized that something was missing.

I did not feel as if I was making any progress towards the vision of Crossdogs, so I sat down and analyzed the situation.

"God always develops character to match His assignment.

He will tell you to make necessary adjustments and to take the first step of obedience.

Ask Him to reveal the truth of your circumstances.

Ash Him to show you His perspective.

You need to bring your experience up to the Word of God and not lower God's ways to match your experience."

I made the conclusion that I had given **God** 99% of my life for **Him** to do with as **He** chose.

I do believe that this procedure was God-inspired.

He has plans for me and those plans mandate a 100% commitment on my part.

I had to give the 1% that I was holding back.

So, I did.

I can't find the proper words, (maybe later I'll be able to) to describe what life has been like since that total surrender decision.

Stage 10: the present

Waiting on the Lord

Now is my "time in the desert" – the most painful and frustrating challenges of being a **Christian** wanting to be used by **God**.

I must wait.

It takes time for **God** to work.

He is constantly arranging circumstances behind the scenes for the future creation of Crossdogs.

I must wait.

"God has to lay some basic foundations in your life before He can prepare you for the larger tasks".

Waiting for most people is not enjoyable.

We have been taught to achieve, to work, to do.

God's world waits for His timing and instructions.

He is in control of everything.

I must wait.

"A vision always requires patience". Visioneering Andy Stanley

"Three things take place while waiting:

- the vision matures in us
- we mature in preparation for the vision
- God is at work behind the scenes preparing the way".

Waiting builds patience.

Waiting builds faith. (if not careful, it can weaken faith)

"Spiritual maturity takes time". Visioneering Andy Stanley

"There is a correlation between the preparation time and the magnitude of the task to which we are called".

In the spring of 2013 at Billy Graham's Cove Retreat, as I sat in a rocking chair waiting for lunch, God/HS spoke to me for the fourth time; He quoted Scripture – Romans 8:28. "And we know that God causes everything to work together for the good of those who love God and are called according to His purpose for them."

This verse is a very powerful, well-known verse among Christians.

It contains a strong promise from **God**, but it only applies to: "those who love **God** and are called according to His purpose for them."

God was telling me **His** channel through which **He** is going to finance the Crossdogs vision.

"When God spoke, the person was sure God was speaking.

When God spoke, the person knew what God said".

In the spring of 2016, again at the Cove, God/HS brought Mary Mac to my mind.

She is my mother's college roommate's daughter.

I wanted to find her and rekindle our childhood friendship some 59 years in the past.

I found & visited her which created an urge in me to visit her homeplace quite a distance from Scotland Neck.
